



#### In the Grünes Haus **Museum visit**

The museum in the Grünes Haus (Green House) is located in Reutte's Untermarkt. The strong shade of green gives the house its name. The wonderful façade was designed in 1779 by Johann Jakob Zeiller. Awaiting you inside are beautiful murals and 11 stuccoed ceilings.

Over around 550m² of exhibition space, you will find a varied and lovingly presented collection. You can see valuable paintings from the painter's workshop of the Zeiller artist family. Well worth seeing are the works of Anna Stainer-Knittel, better known as Geierwally. Visit our clock display and the original-style tavern and discover archaeological finds from our region. The impressive Rodfuhrtafeln tell about the historic heyday of the salt trade in Reutte.
